This product will stabilize pool chlorine and help prevent chlorine loss due to effect of sunlight. Backwash or clean the filter before adding this product to the pool. Maintain a pH of between 7.2 and 7.6.

DIRECTIONS

Read entire label and use strictly in accordance with hazard warnings and directions.

Use one pound of this product per 3,000 gallons of pool water to provide an initial stabilizer level of 40 ppm. The use of one pound per 4,000 gallons of pool water will provide an initial stabilizer level of 30 ppm. Broadcast directly into the pool, scattering over the surface of the water. Use a pool brush to brush any undissolved product off the pool surface. For pools with plastic piping, this product may be slowly added through the skimmer. Keep the water circulating continuously for 24 hours after application. When the product reaches the filter, there may be temporary increase in filter pressure which will dissipate as the product is dissolved. Do not backwash filter for 24 hours after application of stabilizer.

TO DETERMINE POOL CAPACITY:

Rectangular Pools — Length times width times average depth (in feet) times 7.5 equals gallons.

Round and Oval Pools — Average diameter times average diameter times average depth (in feet) times 5.9 equals gallons.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep this product dry in original tightly closed container when not in use. Do not reuse container, but place in trash collection.

HAZARD WARNINGS: CAUTION: May cause eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wear safety glasses when handling this product. May be irritating to nose and throat. Avoid breathing dust. If product gets on clothing, remove and wash before reuse. Do not mix with other chemicals.

FIRST AID

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. If irritation develops, get medical attention.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED: Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.
